






Kitten Vaccine Schedule



Please note: Your Kitten's vaccine schedule will be personalized to meet his or her specific needs. Your doctor may suggest staggering vaccines for individual reasons.

<p>FVRCP #1 1st Feline Distemper Vaccine: feline rhinotracheitis, calici, panleukopenia viruses Booster in 3-4 weeks</p> <p>Intestinal Parasite Screening-Fecal testing for intestinal parasites. Deworm as needed.</p> <p>Feline Triple Test (8 weeks minimum) Tests for Feline Leukemia Virus, Feline Immunodeficiency Virus and Heartworms</p> <p>Revolution Plus- Start on topical flea, tick, heartworm, roundworm, hookworm and ear mite prevention. Apply monthly, year round for the life of your cat based on weight.</p>	<p>FVRCP #2 Feline Distemper Vaccine: feline rhinotracheitis, calici, panleukopenia viruses Booster in 3-4 weeks</p> <p>Revolution Plus- Apply Monthly</p>	<p>FVRCP #3 *14 weeks or more* Final Feline Distemper Vaccine: feline rhinotracheitis, calici, panleukopenia viruses Booster in 1 year</p> <p>Feline Leukemia Vaccine #1- Booster in 3-4 weeks (Recommended for indoor/Outdoor and outdoor only cats)</p> <p>Revolution Plus- Apply Monthly</p>	<p>Feline Leukemia Vaccine #2- Booster in 1 year</p> <p>Rabies Vaccine Booster in 1 year</p> <p>Revolution Plus- Apply Monthly</p>	<p>Spay or Neuter</p> <p>Microchip Insertion</p>	<p>Annual Exam</p> <p>FVRCP Feline Distemper Vaccine: feline rhinotracheitis, calici, panleukopenia viruses Booster in 1 year and then 3 years thereafter.</p> <p>Rabies Vaccine Booster annually</p> <p>Feline Leukemia Vaccine Booster annually (Recommended for indoor/Outdoor and outdoor only cats)</p> <p>Intestinal Parasite Screening- Test a fecal sample yearly for intestinal parasites</p> <p>Revolution Plus- Apply Monthly all year</p>
